On the Move with NYC Real Estate.

It might be winter in the Big Apple, but don't let the season, the Federal Reserve, or news stories about runaway interest rates and inflation scare you into thinking that real estate is stagnating. Buyers and sellers remain active here in NYC, and the rental market continues to show strong demand.

Speaking of deals, January mortgage applications <u>rose 25%</u> nationwide while mortgage interest <u>rates dropped</u> to four-month lows just recently. Not bad considering that the Federal Reserve has pushed benchmark interest rates from 0% less than a year ago into a target range of 4.5-4.75% in its attempt to cool inflation. This month's <u>quarter-point</u> rise actually marks the eighth rate jump since March 2022, an increase lower than expected and a potential turnaround signal.

A Glance at Sales and Prices

The end of January showed a slight dip in <u>contract volume</u> for Manhattan luxury properties, with 15 deals signed during the week beginning January 23. Although down for the fifth straight week since late December, this volume is coming off a 4th quarter that <u>bottomed out</u> in terms of contract numbers and prices.

Looking into sales more closely, a couple significant transactions made recently include a Central Park condo in the world's tallest residential building that sold for <u>over \$60 million</u> and a <u>penthouse</u> at One Waterline

Square that became the most expensive unit put into contract at the complex; its asking price was \$27 million. Besides these notable Manhattan exchanges, the luxury market in Brooklyn has been showing <u>resilience</u>, with the top 10% of the most expensive Brooklyn homes moving for a median sale price of \$3 million—a 10.6% increase from a year ago!


Looking Ahead

Stocks are also showing signs of <u>recovery</u> and <u>international buyers</u> appear poised for entry back into NYC real estate. Altogether, this could be the start of a bustling early spring market. Time will tell.


