NYC Real Estate Off to a Strong Start in the New Year!

After a long year of grappling with low inventory, low sales, and the highest interest rates seen in decades, NYC real estate is poised for a turnaround in 2024. And it's about time!

But before we close the books on 2023, we'd like to share a few impressive points:

- Home sales in NYC <u>set a record</u> this past October, with the citywide median asking price rising to \$1.1 million despite historically high interest rates.
- In mid-December, 24 contracts were signed for homes \$4 million and up—<u>a strong week</u> for luxury real estate sales.
- Foreign investors represented 32% of the city's buyer's market in 2023, marking <u>a 4-year high</u>.

And here's what excites us about 2024:

• Mortgage interest rates <u>dropped to 6.6%</u> in late December and

experts predict they will continue dropping. The National Association of Realtors (NAR) is actually forecasting <u>average</u> rates of 6.3% in 2024.

- Stock markets are <u>looking bullish</u>. That could mean a rise in confidence for both buyers and sellers plus the return of a competitive real estate market.
- NYC rental rates are expected to <u>keep lowering</u> (especially in Manhattan), which may nudge more landlords into the sales market.

Overall, we think real estate here in the Big Apple is setting up to be very active despite inflation, two ongoing wars, a presidential race, and economic uncertainty across the globe. We also anticipate that buyers and sellers will adjust to a new normal as interest rates find their next baseline and inventory re-enters the market.




