

Solid June Ahead for NYC Real Estate—If You Price Right

As summer begins, the real estate market here in NYC is sending some mixed—but promising—signals. We're seeing <u>real</u> momentum, particularly in Manhattan where new listings are appearing at a faster pace than they were a year ago. The luxury segment was especially active in May, with buyers moving decisively when the value was clear.

What's behind the early summer shift? Likely a combination of buyer confidence and a desire among sellers to get ahead of the usual mid-summer slowdown. The stock market's <u>recent rally</u> has added to this momentum—the S&P 500 climbed 6.2% in May, while the Dow ended the month up 3.9%.

Luxury Market Sets the Pace

Manhattan's luxury market continues to set the tone for real estate sales. A recent week in May saw <u>55 contracts signed</u> for properties priced at \$4 million and above—the busiest luxury week since 2021. The month closed out with this market seeing its <u>best week</u> since

May 2006, with the <u>Upper East Side</u> leading the charge.

Rates, Inflation & Rental Pressures

Mortgage rates hovered just below 7% at the end of May, a level that hasn't significantly dampened buyer activity—but one that remains closely tied to national policy. With the Federal Reserve holding its benchmark interest rate at 4.25% to 4.50%, and inflation not yet at the Fed's 2% goal, no rate cuts are expected in the immediate future. Still, buyers who've adjusted to these higher borrowing costs remain active—and many see today's prices as tomorrow's opportunity.

At the same time, Manhattan renters have been facing record-high prices. In April, <u>median rent</u> reached \$4,500, with fewer concessions offered and a persistently tight vacancy rate. Competition remains strong—especially for non-doorman and existing rental units, which continue to set new pricing records.


What's Next for Summer?
